

Applying For Other Forms of Financial Assistance

All undergraduate Veterans, Active Duty, thomal Guard and Reservists should apply for other forms of federal and state assistance.

Applying after this date, but before Juneth still acceptable for the Federal Pell Grant. Please respond promptly to requests for information to complete your application.

In order to apply for all forms of federalitate and USF assistance, a student must complete the Free Application for FædeStudent Aid (FAFSA). Students are encouraged to apply online at www.fafsa.ed.gov

USF also requires students to complete a USF Student Profile, which can be turned in directly to Financial Aid Services or completed online Student ProfileUSF will review your file upon receipt of the FAFSA sults, and completed Student Profile. If needed, supporting documentation will be requested to verify information submitted on the FAFSA.

The most common supporting documents requested are:

USF Verification Form

Student's Federal Income Tax Return Forms: IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ or telefile AND W-2 Forms

Parents' Federal Income Tax Returiorms: IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ or telefile AND W-2 Forms (Dependent students only)

Until the student's financial aid file is complete and verified by Financial Aid Services, no aid can be credited to your bill. Failure to respond to requests for information will result in delays in your award, and the Buesis Office may assess late fees. In general, all full-time students at USF exequired to apply for financial assistance. Application can be waived at the studien request: however, all studentees strongly encouraged to apply for all forms of federal, state and institutional assistance.

Notification of Changes of Award

If the student's award changes as a restularification, a new award letter will be generated signifying the new aumts of the student's awards.

Correction Procedures

All corrections to Student Aid Reports are made electronically through Financial Aid Services. These corrections may inclade and all necessary changes discovered through the verification, schoolanges, dependency oviders, etc. Students are encouraged to not make changes to the student Aid Reports electronic means are available and much more expedientally case where data is electronically corrected, the student is notified given appropriate instituons to dispute the data that was changed.

Additional Procedures for Transfer Students

It is extremely important for both full-tienand part-time transfer students at USF to complete all of the following:

All applications and information quested by Financial Aid Services
All official and final academic transcripthave been received by the appropriate admission office

An official and final evaluation of redit has been completed by Academic Advising

Financial Aid Services will determine loadigibility based upon transfer credits accepted by Academic Advising upon entrance to USF.

Federal Student Loans

Veterans, Active Duty, National Guard and Resets may participate in these federal loan programs if it's necessary. Veteran stats ecciving VA (GI Bill) benefits at the 100% level should definitely to borrow unless it is 100% necessary. Other veterans receiving less than 100%, Active Duty, then all Guard and Reservists should only borrow the amount that may been ded for tuition, fees and books.
